1. Look up the following Scriptures and note the classifications of angels (1 Cor 15:24, Eph 1:21, Eph 6:12, Col 1:16)
The Hebrew for angel is malach, and the Hebrew for king is melek.
2. Read Daniel 10:1-20. What do we learn about angelic appearance and authority?
3. Why would Son be a more royal title than any of the titles the angels carry?
4. What kind of position does the Son have in verses 8-10, that the angels do not?
5. What words are used for angels in 1:7-14?
6. What was humanity supposed to inherit, according to Hebrews 2:5-8 (quoting Psalm 8)? How did this human inheritance become ruled by angels instead?
7. How was “the world to come” won back, so as to be man's inheritance?
8. Compare Christ, angels and man. Who is greater or lower, before and after the Fall, before and after the Incarnation and Resurrection, and before and after the New Heavens & New Earth?
